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WOMEN LEADERS ARE RESHAPING STRATEGY IN EDUCATION

Across the global education sector, leadership is gradually evolving from operational management to strategic institution building. As universities and schools respond to technological disruption, shifting workforce demands and changing social expectations, women leaders are increasingly influencing how institutions define their purpose, research priorities and governance frameworks.

MOST UNIVERSITY STAFF ARE WOMEN, BUT NOT AT PROFESSOR LEVEL

Over the past 25 years, women's participation in academia and advancement into senior leadership roles has increased significantly. However, notable disparities in promotion and recognition remain.

Since 2000, women have represented more than 50% of those employed in Australian universities. This proportion has increased every year since, except for 2021, where a 0.1 point decrease was observed due to universities' restructuring influenced by the pandemic. The latest published figures refer to 2024, when women represented 59.7% of the workforce. [Continue reading...](#)
